LIU MFA student Jason Capone brings us his ongoing homage to Ray Johnson's "Nothangs."

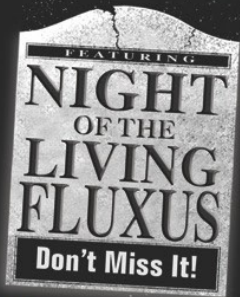
Acolytes of Ray Johnson's NYC Correspondence School, Louise Millmann and Nadine Boulter bring us a special surprise performance.
